

5th Grade Supply List- 2024-2025

- * A 3 ring binder
- * 8 plastic **double sided pocket** colored dividers to go in the binder--I recommend Avery (they are sturdy) **Please do not label these as we will do this at school**.
- * a supply of #2 pencils--Dixon Ticonderoga work very well and are easy to sharpen
- * ESV (English Standard Version) Bible to be kept at school or brought in every day
- * highlighter- any color is fine
- * A large eraser
- * An art shirt labeled with your child's name; please send it in a gallon Ziploc baggie that is also labeled
- * A ruler with inches and centimeters
- * 2 red pens
- * 2 paper (not plastic) folders with pockets (be sure there are no academic hints inside)
- * 2 plastic folders (one red and one green) with pockets (brads are optional)
- * 2 boxes of tissues to be shared with the class
- * A set of whiteboard markers (FINE TIP RECOMMENDED) and eraser---whiteboards will be provided
- * Scissors- Please be sure they are large enough for your child's growing fingers
- * Several glue sticks
- * 3 **one-subject** spiral notebooks---any colors are fine
- * a set of headphones or earbuds –please bring these to school in a labeled, plastic Ziploc bag
- * a wired (not wireless) mouse to use with classroom Chromebooks
- * fine-tip black sharpie (we will use the first day to help with labels)
- * pencil box large enough to hold loose pens/pencils/highlighters, etc...
- * an open mind and positive attitude:)
- * 1 box/bag of plastic spoons or forks
- * AN OPEN MIND THAT IS READY TO LEARN AND HAVE FUN!
- **BINDERS/FOLDERS will be labeled and "set up" at school. Please remove folders from the plastic, and have them in your binder for the first day of school. We will label the tabs together.
